- 7) and Iraq and Syria to the southeast

- *Turkey has 81 cities and 7 regions.*





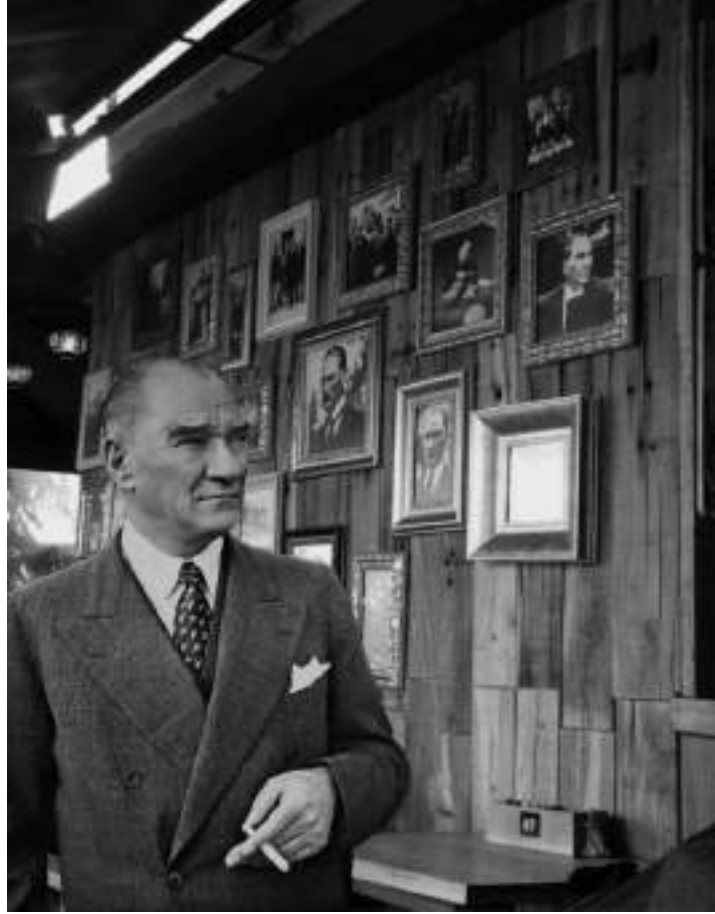
- *Although the capital is mostly thought to be Istanbul, it is Ankara.*
